Letter dated 28 March 1967 from the Permanent Representative of the United States of America addressed to the Secretary-General

In accordance with the provision of part B, paragraphs 1 and 2, of United Nations General Assembly resolution 1721 (XVI), I enclose registration data concerning objects launched into orbit or beyond by the United States.
