The Permanent Mission of Italy to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretariat of the United Nations and has the honour to inform that: "A scientific satellite, named San Marco II, was launched by a Scout vehicle on 26 April 1967, from a mobile range off Formosa Bay (Kenya). Basic characteristics: perigee 218 km; apogee 748 km; equatorial orbit".
