INTRODUCTION

- COMESA is regional economic grouping comprising twenty member states in Northern, Eastern and Southern Africa
- Currently an FTA which commenced in 2000
- Preparing for Customs Union in 2008





The main COMESA Programmes can be broadly classified under the following areas:

- Trade, Customs and Monetary Cooperation
- Investment and Private Sector Development
- > Agriculture
- Infrastructure Development

Programmes in Infrastructure



- **Transport**
 - Civil Aviation
 - Road and Rail
 - Maritime and Inland Waterways

Communications

- Development of Physical Infrastructure Terrestrial and Wireless Communications
- Creating an enabling environment through harmonisation of policy and regulatory issues



Programmes in Infrastructure

Energy

- Promotion of increased regional power generation and interconnectivity
- Cooperation in the procurement, transportation of petroleum products
- Cooperation in the exploitation of other energy sources

Meteorology

Cooperation in the collection and dissemination of Met information

Specific Programmes Involving GNSS



- Civil Aviation
 - CNS/ATM Systems
 - Currently a joint study covering COMESA, SADC and EAC is being undertaken to implement this programme
- Road Transport
 - Cargo and Equipment tracking in road and rail (ACIS)
 - Currently there are several trucking companies using GPS

Specific Programmes Involving GNSS



- Agriculture
 - Crop Forecasts through Remote Sensing
- Meteorology
 - Collection and sharing of Met information among countries

Regional Economic Communities (RECs)



- Joint Studies for CNS/ATM Systems within COMESA, EAC and SADC
- Cooperation with other RECs in Africa namely CEMAC, ECOWAS, UEMOA during the validation of studies for CNS/ATM
- Use of common transport facilitation instruments in Eastern and Southern Africa (Advance Cargo Information System-ACIS, Global Tracking)
- Joint Regional ICT Support Programme with EAS, IGAD and IOC



Recommendations

- Develop both national and regional capacity to tap and utilise GNSS products
- Share resources where possible in order to eliminate duplication of efforts
- Enhance regional cooperation in negotiating for the rights and terms of access to the GNSS infrastructure from the providers
