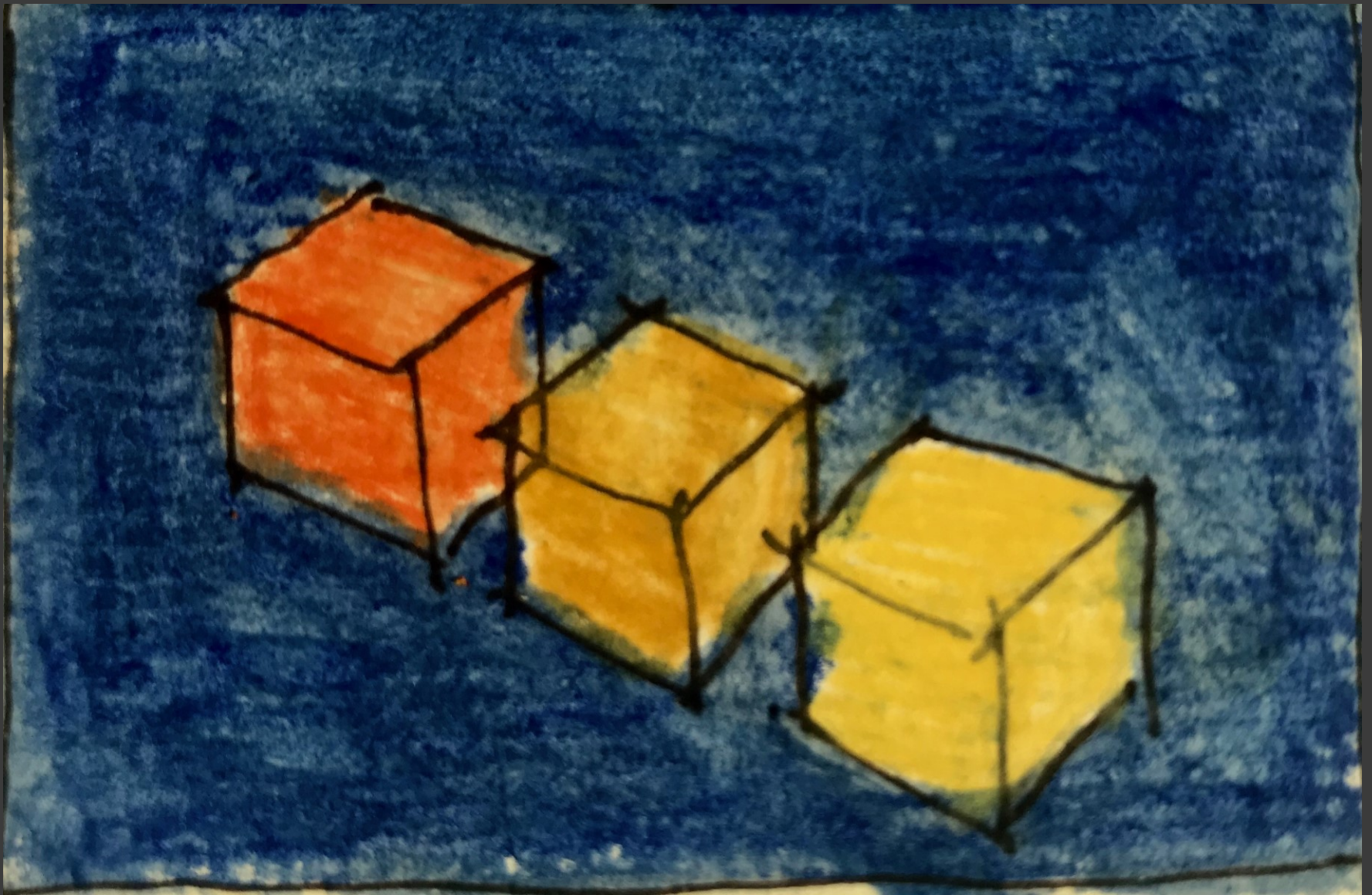

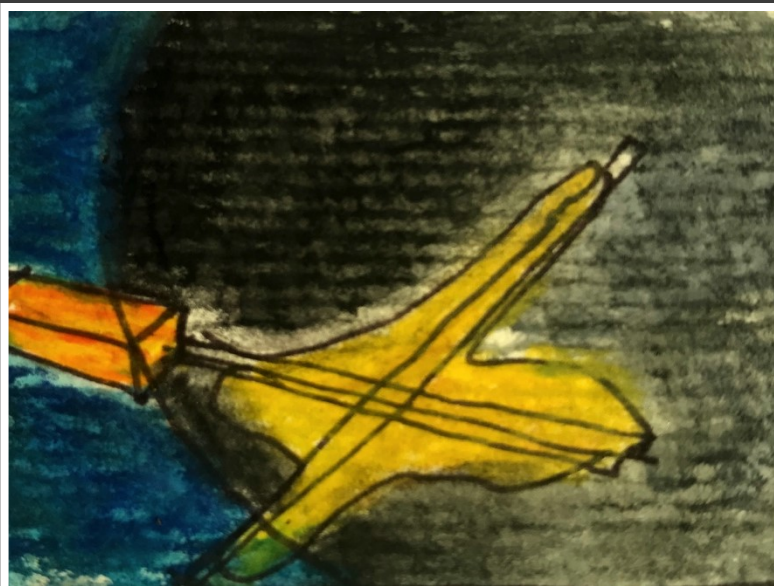

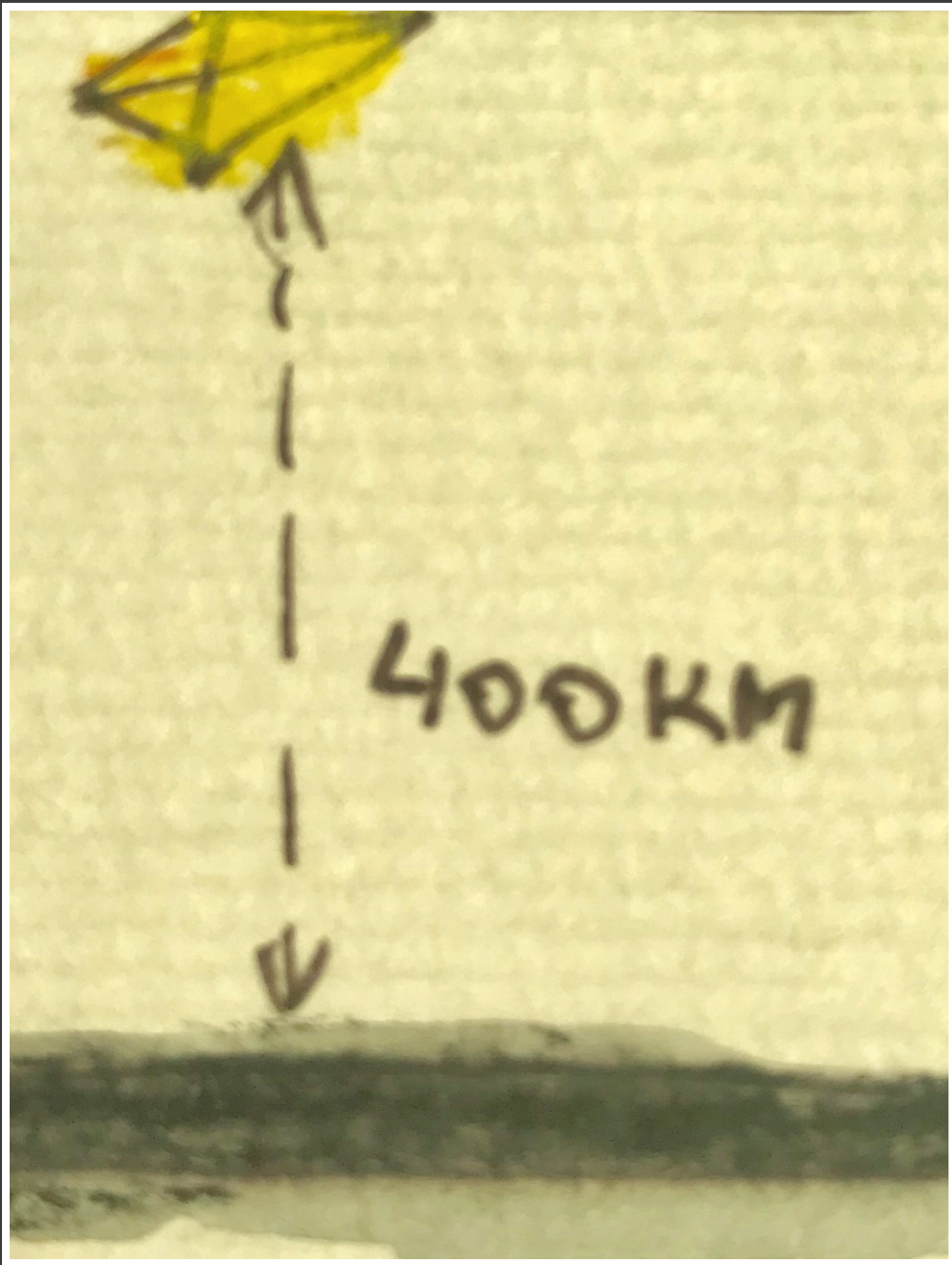

Slowly, in the sky above us appears a new tiny light in the horizon

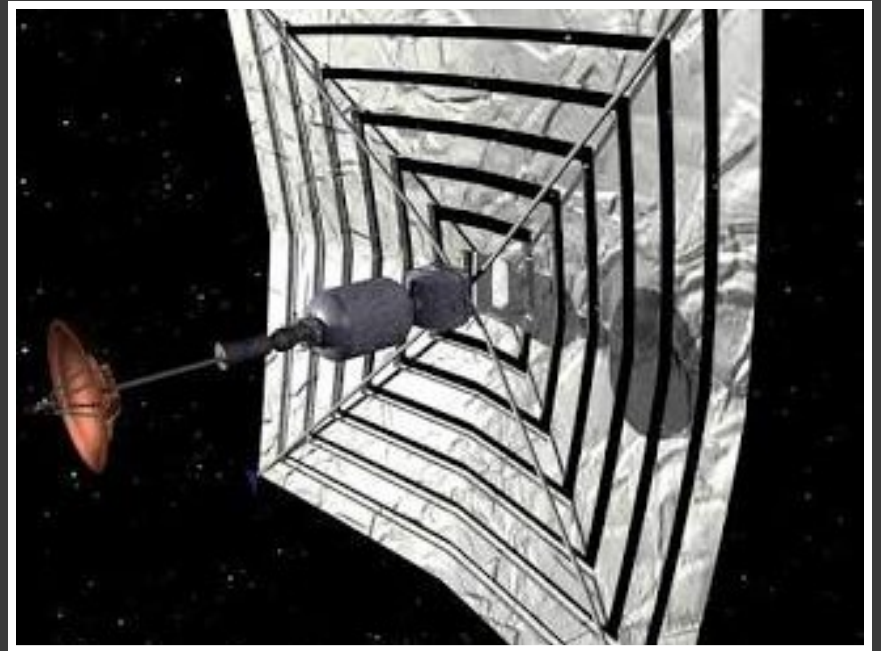


The sail deploys in orbit

The solar wind "blows" the sail as the wind does with a boat on sea.



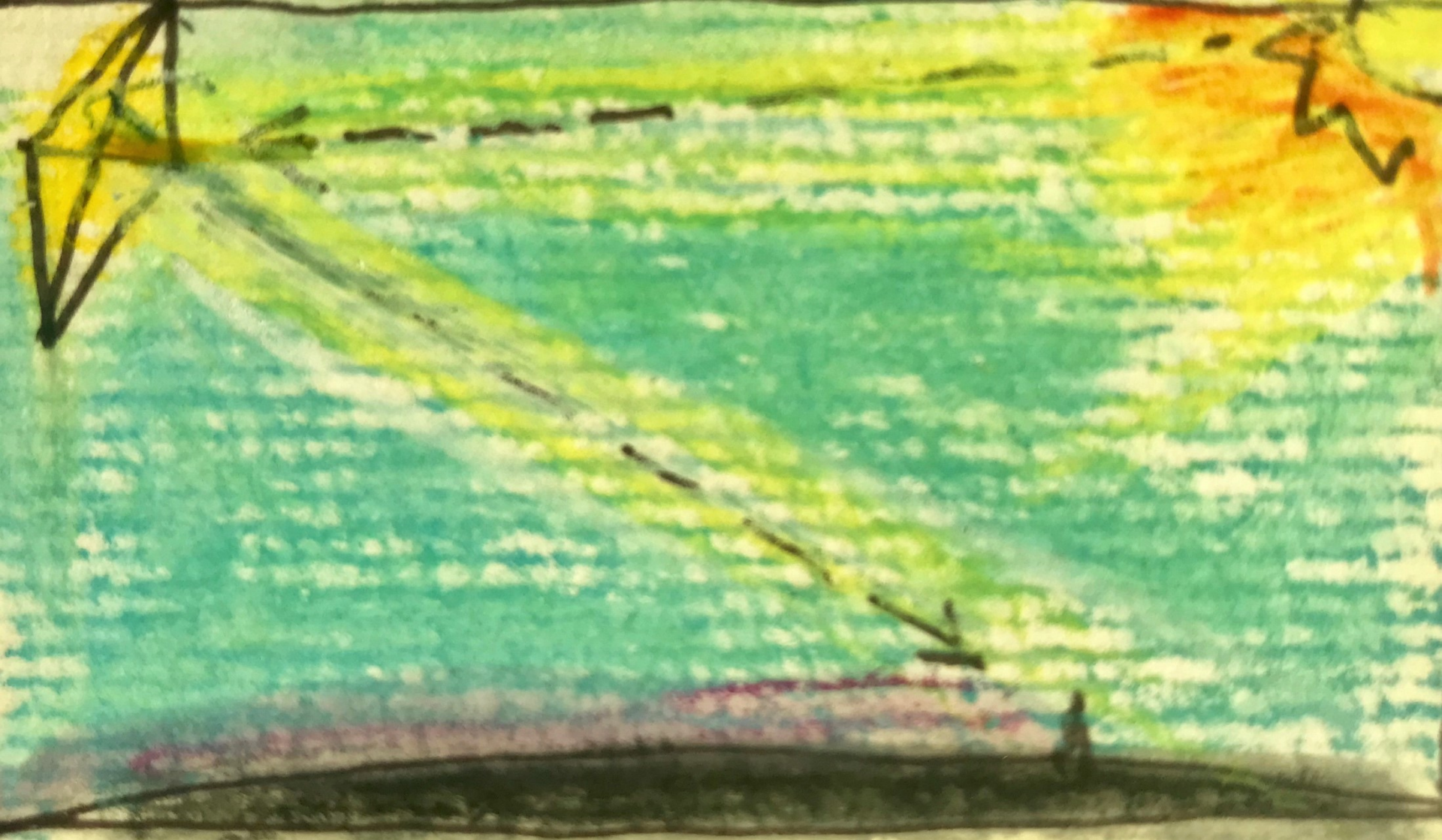

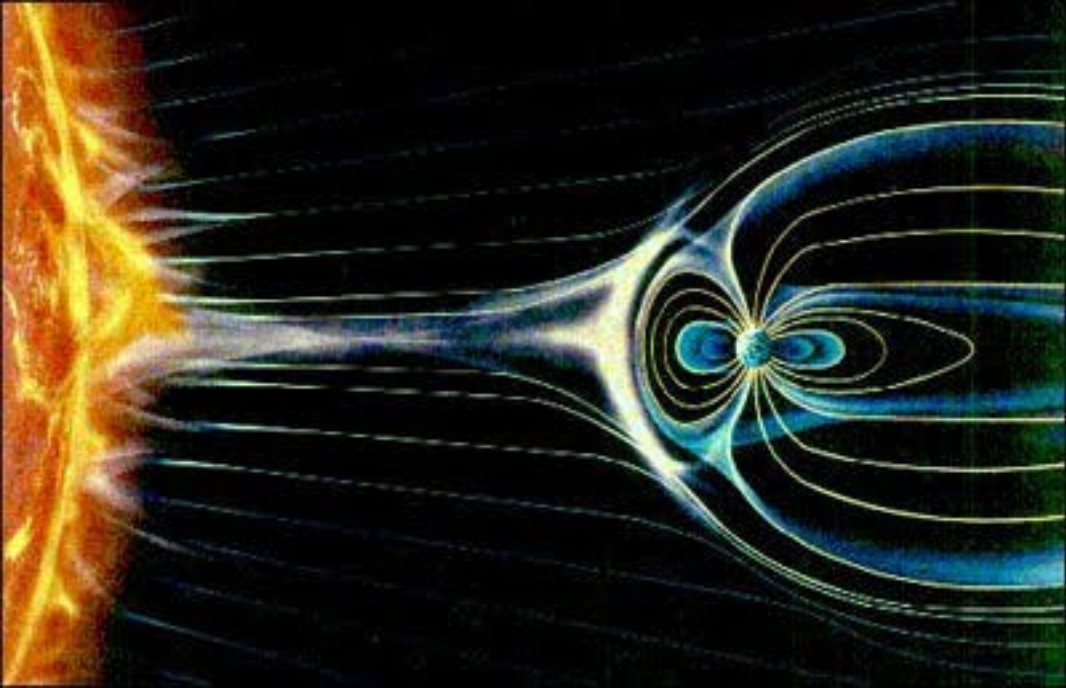
Sunlight

of ISS

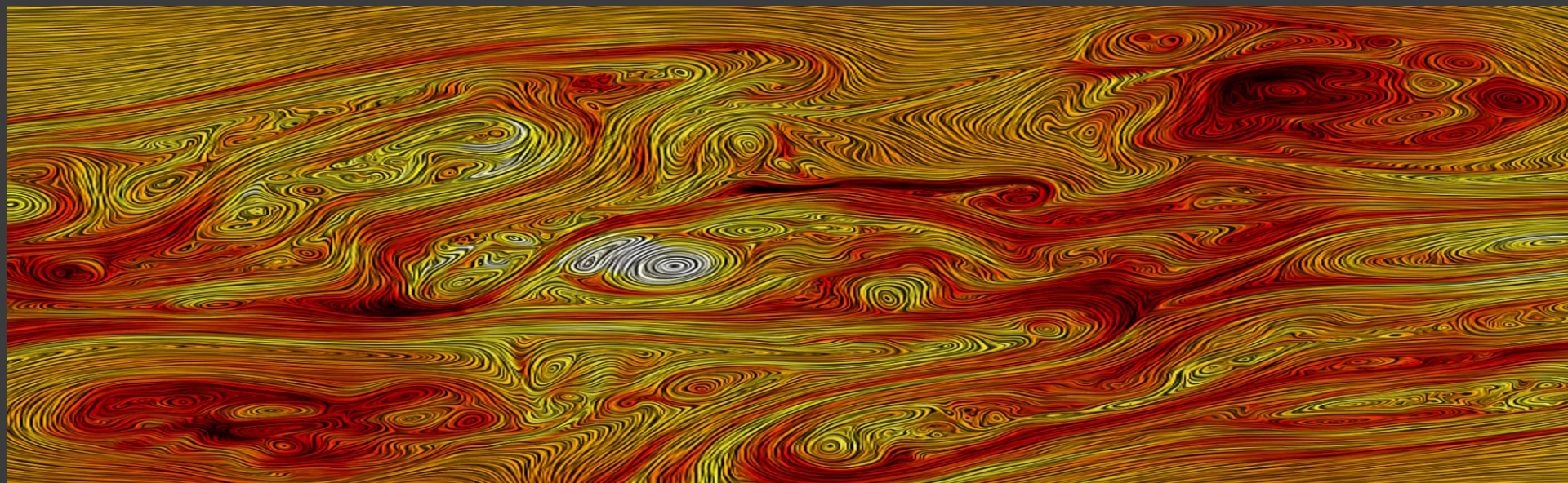
