Note verbale dated 19 May 1989 from the Permanent Mission of Japan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

The Permanent Mission of Japan to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to notify him, in conformity with article IV of the Convention on Registration of Objects Launched into Outer Space, adopted by the General Assembly of the United Nations on 12 November 1974, that space objects OHZORA (1984-015A) and TENMA (1983-011A), whose registration details were previously transmitted to the Secretary-General, are no longer in Earth orbit and have not been since 2400 (Japan time) on 26 December 1988, and 2400 (Japan time) on 19 January 1989, respectively.
