The Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to inform him, in accordance with article IV of the 1975 Convention on Registration of Objects Launched into Outer Space, that the United Kingdom-registered space object Uosat 1, designation 1981 100B, launched on 6 October 1981, has now decayed and is no longer in Earth orbit. The bulletin of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) of the United States of America confirming the decay of Uosat 1 is attached. The object has now been removed from the United Kingdom register.
