859<sup>th</sup> meeting

## **Symposium**

A scientific symposium on the theme "The UNIDROIT Space Protocol" co-organized by the International Institute of Space Law (IISL) and the European Centre for Space Law (ECSL), was held during the 860<sup>th</sup> session of the Legal Subcommittee. The symposium was co-chaired by Ms. Tanja Masson-Zwaan, President of IISL and Mr. Sergio Marchisio, President of ECSL with a welcome statement made by Mr. Tare Brisibe, Chair of the Legal Subcommittee.

Presentations were made by Mr. Martin Stanford, International Institute for the Unification of Private Law (UNIDROIT), Italy; Mr. Bernhard Schmidt-Tedd, DLR, Germany and Mr. Stephan Hobe, University of Cologne, Germany; Mr. Patrick Phetole Sekhula, South African Council for Space Affairs, South Africa, and Ms. Tanja Masson-Zwaan on behalf of Mr. Chris Johnson of the University of Leiden, the Netherlands.

Concluding remarks were made by the Chair of the Legal Subcommittee and by the Co-Chairs of the Symposium.
