The forty-third session of the SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNICAL SUBCOMMITTEE of the COMMITTEE ON THE PEACEFUL USES OF OUTER SPACE will be convened on Monday, 20 February 2006, at 10:00 a.m. in Conference Room III, on the seventh floor of Building C. The provisional agenda for the session is contained in document A/AC.105/C.1/L.283.

An industry symposium on the theme “Synthetic aperture radar missions and their applications” will be convened on Monday, 20 February 2006, at 3:00 p.m., in Conference Room III of building C.

A joint technical workshop on the objectives, scope and general attributes of a potential technical safety standard for nuclear power sources in outer space, organized by the Scientific and Technical Subcommittee of the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space and the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), will be held from 20 to 22 February 2006 in Conference Room I, on the second floor of Building C. The workshop will begin its work on Monday, 20 February 2006, following the opening of the forty-third session of the Scientific and Technical Subcommittee.
