**Suggested amendments to the document “Proposal for a
draft report and a preliminary set of draft guidelines of the
Working Group on the Long-term sustainability of outer
space activities” (A/AC.105/C.1/L.339)**

Proposal submitted by Pakistan

Pakistan suggests the following amendment to the existing draft guidelines:

“Outer space is a common heritage of mankind and the community of nations must support any instrument and process which contributes to the safety, security and sustainability of outer space activities, while rejecting militarization of outer space and placement of any kind of conventional and/or nuclear weapons in outer space.

Space-faring nations should assist the new entrants towards the implementation of space debris mitigation measures through provision of Conjunction Assessment Risk Analysis (CARA) systems, Situational Awareness Systems for live monitoring of space objects and arranging financing of projects to absorb additional costs incurred.”
