

- The Importance of Making International Rules to Protect Space Environment – (Prof. Setsuko Aoki, Keio University)
 - Encourage continued discussion on the protection of space environment under the framework of APRSAF; (Recommendation #39);
- Mr. David Turner, Deputy Director, Office of Space and Advanced Technology, U.S. Department of State, USA
 - Reiterated the importance of space exploration at the international Space Exploration Forum (ISEF) held in Washington D. C. last month.

ISEF will build on a process started at the EU-hosted high level international space exploration dialogue, and Japan will host the next forum in Tokyo, 2016 or 2017.

- Strengthen Initiatives



First Initiative born from APRSAF for disaster management -


- Sentinel Asia Step 3 has started to support all disaster phases to tackle with recent frequent catastrophic disasters in Asia-Pacific region
- In order to cover all the phases, Sentinel Asia decided to establish a Task Force Team to develop a plan of action, and to strengthen communication and relationship with partners








