Note verbale dated 13 June 1979 from the Permanent
Representative of Czechoslovakia to the United
Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

The Permanent Representative of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to advise that, in accordance with article II of the 1975 Convention on Registration of Objects Launched into Outer Space, the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic has established a Czechoslovak national register of objects launched into outer space by the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic within the INTERCOSMOS programme. The Czechoslovak Academy of Sciences is authorized to furnish the Secretary-General of the United Nations with the information referred to in article IV of the Convention.*
