Note verbale dated 6 April 1998 from the Permanent Mission of Sweden to the United Nations (Vienna) addressed to the Secretary-General

The Permanent Mission of Sweden presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to inform him, in accordance with article IV, paragraph 3, of the Convention on Registration of Objects Launched into Outer Space,* that the Swedish satellite Tele-X, registration number 89.027.01 (document ST/SG/SER.E/203), has ceased functioning. The satellite was switched off on 16 January 1998, after having been transferred to a graveyard orbit, 300 kilometre above the geostationary orbit.
