754th meeting

Opening of the session [1]

The session was opened at its 754th meeting.

A Special Event hosted by the United States of America on the theme “The legacy of the Apollo 11 Mission: the future of space exploration” was held as part of the morning meeting.

Adoption of the agenda [2]

The provisional agenda (A/AC.105/L.316) was adopted.

Statements were made by the representatives of Australia, Canada, China, Cuba, France, Iran (Islamic Republic of), Israel, Italy, New Zealand, the Russian Federation, Syrian Arab Republic, the United Kingdom, the United States and Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of).

Statement by the Chair [3]

The Chair made a statement outlining the work of the Committee.

General exchange of views [4]

The Committee began its consideration of this item with statements by the representatives of Nigeria on behalf of the Group of African States, Chile on behalf of a group of Latin American States¹, Austria, Finland, Iran (Islamic Republic of) and Italy.

The observer for the European Union also made a statement.

The Director of the Office for Outer Space Affairs also made a statement.

The Committee continued its consideration of this item with statements by the representatives of Egypt on behalf of the Group of 77 and China, Belarus, Belgium, Brazil, China, Cyprus, India, Japan, Jordan, Republic of Korea, Romania, the Russian Federation, Spain, Switzerland, Ukraine and the United Arab Emirates.

The observer for International Space University also made a statement.
