

1040th meeting

General exchange of views [3]

The Subcommittee continued its consideration of this item with statements by the representatives of Bulgaria, Colombia, India, Netherlands (Kingdom of the), the Philippines and the Russian Federation.

Information on the activities of international intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations relating to space law [4]

The Subcommittee concluded its consideration of this item with statements by the observers for the Asia-Pacific Space Cooperation Organization (APSCO), For All Moonkind, the International Organization of Space Communications (Intersputnik), the Open Lunar Foundation and the Secure World Foundation (SWF).

General exchange of views on the application of international law to small-satellite activities [14]

The Subcommittee concluded its consideration of this item with statements by the representatives of Colombia, India and Indonesia.

The observer for the SKA Observatory (SKAO) also made a statement.

General exchange of views on potential legal models for activities in the exploration, exploitation and utilization of space resources [10]

The Subcommittee continued its consideration of this item with statements by the representatives of Argentina, France, Germany, Indonesia, Malaysia, New Zealand, Pakistan, the Russian Federation and the United States of America.

The Subcommittee began its consideration of this item with statements by the representatives of Finland, France, Japan, Mexico, the Russian Federation, the United States and Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of).
