SUMMARY OF SCHEDULED MEETINGS

818th meeting

Opening of the session [1]

The session was opened at its 818th meeting.

Adoption of the Agenda [2]

The provisional agenda (A/AC.105/L.333) was adopted.

The Committee decided to admit the representatives of Djibouti, Lao (People’s Democratic Republic of) and Nepal to participate in the session as observers.

The Committee decided to admit the representatives of the Holy See and the League of Arab States to participate in the session as observers.

The Committee decided to admit the observers of the Global Satellite Operators Association (GSOA), the International Genetically Engineered Machine Foundation (iGEM Foundation) and the Space Renaissance International (SRI) to participate in the session as observers.

Election of Officers [3]

Mr. Sherif Mohamed Sedky of Egypt for the 2024 session and Mr. Rafiq Akram of Morocco for the 2025 session were elected to the office of Chair of the Committee. Mr. Juan Francisco Facetti Fernandez of Paraguay was elected to the office of First Vice-Chair of the Committee for the period 2024-2025, and Mr. Hasan Abbas of Pakistan for 2024 and Ms. Hesa Al-Khalifa of Bahrain for 2025 were elected to the office of Second Vice-Chair/Rapporteur of the Committee.
