

The additional information concerns a change of status of the space object. The space object is no longer in low Earth orbit. The satellite re-entered the Earth's atmosphere on 9 January 2024.

The space object referred to above is included in the national part of the Kingdom of the Netherlands registry of objects launched into outer space (Register ruimtevoorwerpen).¹
